PENNELL MISSION GROUP

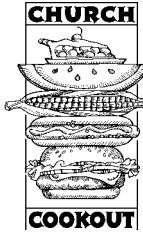
The Pennell Mission Group will meet on Monday July 20th at 10:00 am in the fellowship hall.
